Public Safety Dispatcher **Kevin Jennings**, Communications, married Sarah Butts on Saturday, June 28, 2008.

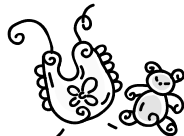

WELL DONE

On Friday, June 20, 2008, Officer **Alexander Jenne**, Central County Precinct, responded to a residence for a report of a stabbing. The victim stated that his girlfriend stabbed him twice with a kitchen knife and fled on foot. A witness saw the assault and the direction of travel of the suspect. Officer Jenne received information that the suspect may be at a nearby address. Upon checking the address, the knife used was discovered stuck in the grass near the home. Officer Jenne saw the intoxicated suspect come out of the home and took her into custody.

Also on Friday, June 20, 2008, Officer **Patrick Trentham**, North County Precinct, responded to an attempt burglary in progress. The victim stated that three subjects were trying to pry open the rear door of his home. Upon arrival at the scene, Officer Trentham saw three subjects walking nearby who matched the descriptions of the suspects. He exited his car and one of the subjects fled on foot. Officer Trentham arrested the other two who were immediately identified by the victim as the suspects, and who were in possession of burglar tools. A neighborhood canvass revealed other nearby homes had recent pry marks and screens removed in an attempt to gain entry.

On Thursday, June 26, 2008, Police Officers **Leslie Robertson** and **Kent Menning**, City of Fenton Precinct, responded to a robbery at Shop-N-Save involving a knife. The suspects had fled prior to their arrival, however, a security video showed a possible direction of travel. The security officer provided a partial plate number. Using the in-car computer, Officer Robertson searched the DOR files and found ten possible vehicles with three types matching the make and model provided. One matched the vehicle description registered in Jefferson County, not far from the store. Detective **Devin Rose**, DCI, and Officer Robertson found and arrested the suspects without incident. The next day, Detective Rose obtained Robbery First Degree warrants on both suspects with \$50,000 bond on each.

On Wednesday, July 2, 2008, Officers **Joseph Goforth** and **Terry Wilkerson**, South County Precinct, responded to a gas station for a larceny in progress. The attendant stated that a subject pumped \$70 in gas but had failed to pay and was acting peculiar. The officers contacted the subject and learned that he could not get his pickup truck started. The officers noticed that the rear window of the pickup was shattered and that the license plates were not registered to the vehicle. An investigation resulted in discovering that the vehicle was stolen the night before and the suspect was already wanted by our Auto Crime Unit for stealing a motor vehicle.

COMPUTER TIPS

It has come to our attention that several employees are having trouble accessing their Department email from home using personal computers. While the address is the same, the link/shortcut saved on your personal computer is using extra "junk" in the address bar which needs to be removed. To fix this, delete your current shortcut and re-open Internet Explorer in a new window. Enter the address <https://owa2.stlouisco.com/exchange>, this will bring up the new entry screen.

You can now create a new shortcut to this page. If you do not delete the old link/shortcut from your Favorites/Desktop, you will encounter the same problem each time you use the old link.

Also, many Department employees are reporting that they have received spoofing email. If you receive an email with the entire Department email address (i.e., dfulton@stlouisco.com) as opposed to just the sender's name, this will most likely be an indication that you are receiving spoofing email. In addition, many of these emails come with attachments. Do not open any attachments, and forward the email to the REJIS Helpdesk, asking them to notify the County email administrator.
