

## Public Informational Meeting

On January 25, 2012, representatives from the Saint Louis County Department of Highways & Traffic will discuss construction of the Kehrs Mill Road/Long Road improvement project. This public informational meeting will take place from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Chesterfield City Hall. A presentation will be given at 6:30 p.m.

When construction of the Kehrs Mill Road/Long Road improvement project is complete, there will be five traffic lanes (two northbound, two southbound, and a continuous two-way center left turn lane), enclosed storm drainage, eight-foot (8') wide concrete sidewalks on both sides of the roadway, a new bridge over Bonhomme Creek, a new single 10' x 8' concrete box culvert, retaining walls, full depth asphalt pavement, traffic signals, sodding, and seeding.

Please join Saint Louis County Department of Highways & Traffic representatives who will begin the presentation with a brief look back at the development/design process leading to construction. Learn about the construction schedule that will allow completion of this project in June 2013 as well as the major milestone and detour activity that could affect your daily commute.
