

Lemay County Park Trail Guide

This park was created with buy-out funds available from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as a result of the Great Flood of 1993. Floodwaters from the Mississippi River backed up River Des Peres and flooded this area of Lemay for over 6 weeks. Water depths were over 8 feet throughout this portion of town. The park was officially dedicated in 1996. The park has two picnic shelters, athletic fields and a playground.

Fitness Course Trail

One Mile Flat Paved Bike/Pedestrian/Roller Sports

The one mile fitness trail winds around the park with numerous fitness stations along the way. The trail is flat and handicapped accessible.
