

## **McDonnell Park Trail Guide**

**This 133 acre park is a mix of active recreation areas and passive woodlands and old fields. Most of the park is undeveloped and is on the west side of Adie Road. Like many of the parks, McDonnell suffers from exotic plants. Honeysuckle, vetch, fescue, all threaten the naturalness of the park.**

**McDonnell Park was purchased with 1977 Bond Issue funds and a grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund. The park was opened in 1978. The park is named after James S. McDonnell founder of McDonnell Douglas Aircraft, which became a part of Boeing.**

### **McDonnell Trail**

**1.6 mile      Moderate      Paved Treadway      Hiker & Biker**

**The 1.6 mile asphalt McDonnell Trail is a figure 8 configuration. The trail is multi-use with the exception being horses. The trail is well shaded as it goes through an oak woodland. The trail is marked as moderate difficulty due to some small hills that have to be climbed. There are 12 exercise stations along the trail route. Whether just wanting a nice walk through the park or a complete workout McDonnell Trail has what you are looking for.**
