HOW DO I REGISTER FOR PROGRAMS?

Registration is taken at our facility, on a first-come, first-served basis in person, by phone, or online at www.stlouisco.com. Staff assistance is available 9am-4pm Monday through Friday. Classes may be combined or cancelled based on enrollment. Due to skill requirements, registration is not accepted after the first class has met. Registration opens on specific dates and is limited. Please place your child in the ability level most appropriate for current skills.

Please be sure of your availability when registering, as a processing charge of \$20 is placed on any request to change or cancel. Cancellation requests require a minimum of 30 days notice before program begins. Requests with less than 30 days notice will not be refunded. Make-up classes or credits are not offered for unattended lessons. Programs cancelled by St. Louis County will be refunded in full. There is a \$15 charge for returned checks.

IMPORTANT SKATING PROGRAM INFORMATION

Classes meet on specific days and times for each session. Tot enrollment includes skate rental for child's shoe-size 8 and larger. For all others, an additional skate rental fee of \$1.00 is paid weekly. Please place your child in the ability level that is most appropriate for their current skills. Figure skates are recommended through Beta level.

For all classes a light-weight jacket and helmet are recommended but not required; however, gloves are advisable for all.

To complete each ability level, participants test on last class day and must successfully demonstrate specific skills.
