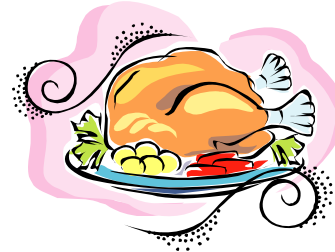

### Swanson's Sausage & Apple Stuffing

- 1-3/4 cups Swanson Chick Broth
- Generous dash ground black pepper
- 1 stalk celery, chopped
- 1 small onion, chopped
- ½ red apple chopped
- ½ green apple chopped
- ½ pound bulk pork sausage, cooked and crumbled
- 2 cups Pepperidge Farm Cubed Herb Seasoned Stuffing
- 2 cups Pepperidge Farm Corn Bread Stuffing



Directions: Heat broth, pepper, celery, onion and apples in 3-quart saucepan over medium high heat to a boil. Reduce heat to low. Cover and cook for 5 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Add sausage and stuffing and stir lightly to coat.

### Ultimate Double Chocolate Cookies

- 1 bag (11.5 oz) Bittersweet Chocolate Chips
- 6 Tbsp. (3/4 stick) unsalted butter
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- ½ tsp. Baking powder
- 1 bag (12 oz) Semi-Sweet Chocolate Chips
- 1 cup (4 oz) chopped walnuts



Directions: In double boiler over hot water, melt bittersweet chocolate chips and butter. In large bowl with electric mixer, beat eggs and sugar until thick; stir in chocolate mixture. In small bowl, stir together flour and baking powder; stir into chocolate mixture. Gently mix in semi-sweet chocolate chips and walnuts. On a sheet of plastic wrap, form dough into two logs (each 2 inches in diameter and about 8 inches long). Wrap tightly and refrigerate at least 1 hour or until firm. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Unwrap dough; with sharp knife cut into ¾ inch slices. Place slices 1 ½ inches apart on greased cookie sheet. Bake 12 to 14 minutes, until shiny crust forms on top. Cool.
