### VETERANS SERVICES

**\*\*ALL VETERANS** are eligible for **“PRIORITY SERVICE”**

These services are offered through the Disabled Veterans Outreach Program and the Local Veterans Employment Representative Program. Disabled Veterans Outreach Program Specialists provided case management and direct development and training opportunities for veterans, with special emphasis on veterans with service-connected disabilities.

In addition, veterans with significant barriers to employment are eligible for:

- Assessment of the veterans needs related to their search for employment
- Counseling through case management
- Job Development
- Testing
- Transitional assistance to separating service members
- Identification of employment and training opportunities and direct referrals to jobs
- Monitoring job listing from federal contractors to ensure eligible veterans get priority referrals to these jobs
- Monitoring Career Centers to ensure priority of service to veterans
- Monitoring federal department and agency vacancy listing
- Referral screening of complaints from veterans regarding observance of veteran’s preference in federal hiring to the Director of Employment and Training Service
- Provide information to veterans and schools on the troops to teachers program
