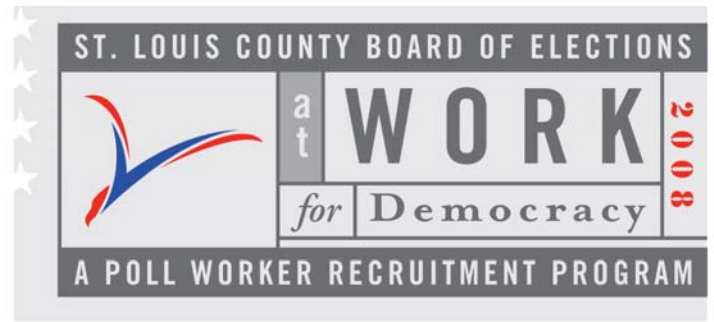

Sign up to be a poll worker today!

Several times a year, you have the right and privilege to cast your vote in an election. The process of voting is simple, but did you know it takes nearly 5,000 poll workers to support each election in St. Louis County?

With a small investment of time — *only a few days each year* — you can make an important contribution to the vitality of the democratic process in our community.

St. Louis County is embarking on an aggressive poll worker recruitment program — and we need your help!

What Can You Do?

St. Louis County needs individuals to serve as poll workers on Election Day. Poll workers are paid for their service! To be a poll worker, you must:

- Be a registered voter
- Have declared a political party preference
- Attend a poll worker training session

- Service as a poll worker helps the election process run smoothly and ensures the integrity of the outcome.
- Poll workers are paid for their important service.
- St. Louis County has a public recognition program to honor poll workers in significant ways.
- Poll worker service provides a unique fundraising opportunity when compensation is pooled toward a common cause.

Did you know?

- Poll workers are compensated for their service. The starting pay is \$130.00. You will be paid approximately 3 – 4 weeks after your service.
- The duties of a poll worker include opening the polls on time, processing voters, issuing ballots, and helping to resolve issues that may occur.
- The comprehensive poll worker training is approximately two hours in length.

Do you know how to turn \$100 into \$10,000? We do!

Poll workers are paid for their service, with compensation beginning at \$130. Are you a part of an organization? You can create a great fundraiser by engaging your members to serve as poll workers, and encouraging them to pool the earnings toward a worthy cause, or to support your own service organization.

The process works best with the support of *all* Missouri citizens! There is a way for all eligible citizens to serve as poll workers.
