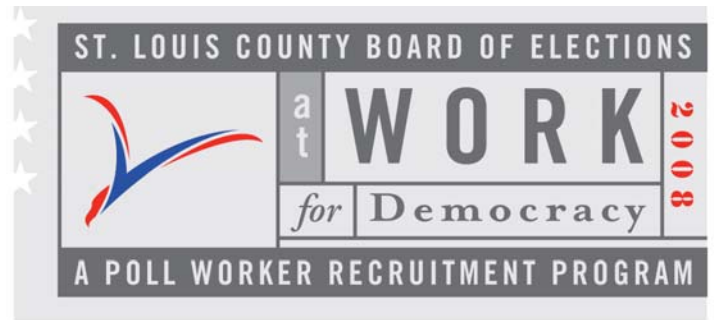


## Organization Partner Program

St. Louis County needs the support of the entire community to maintain the vitality and integrity of the election process. There's a role for everyone to play – including good corporate citizens like you. For a small investment of time — *just a few days each year* — the rewards are great. Not only will you give back to the community in a meaningful way, but poll worker service provides opportunities for recognition, compensation, and reputation-building!

### **Our Proposal**

- ❑ Engage your employees to serve as poll workers in an upcoming election.  
**Performance Targets**

Under 100 employees:	10% of workforce
100 – 500 employees:	15-25 poll workers
More than 500 employees:	25+ poll workers
- ❑ Turn \$100 into \$10,000! Poll worker pay starts at \$130. As an alternative to keeping their payment, you could organize a fundraiser and encourage employees to pool their poll worker compensation for a significant charitable contribution.
- ❑ We strongly encourage you to consider giving employees the day off to serve at the polls. Just as citizens are allowed time on Election Day to vote, it is equally important to give time to ensure proper staffing of polling locations.

### **The Full Benefits Package**

- ❑ We'll provide you with full support for your participation. Our tool kit includes awareness posters, template e-mail and newsletter communications, and help ideas for how to motivate your employees!
- ❑ We can offer a total of 500 special half-shifts. Please note, you must sign up for a split shift in teams. You can only split a shift with someone of your same party to ensure an equal balance of Democrats and Republicans at all times. You must wait until your partner arrives before ending your shift.
- ❑ We offer a poll worker recognition program to make sure your organization is properly recognized for its contribution to the election process. You'll be recognized on the St. Louis County Web site, and publicly announced during Poll Worker Recognition Week. As part of our active media relations program, we'll be sure the local media is aware of your company's efforts. You'll also receive a certificate of recognition from the county for public display.
