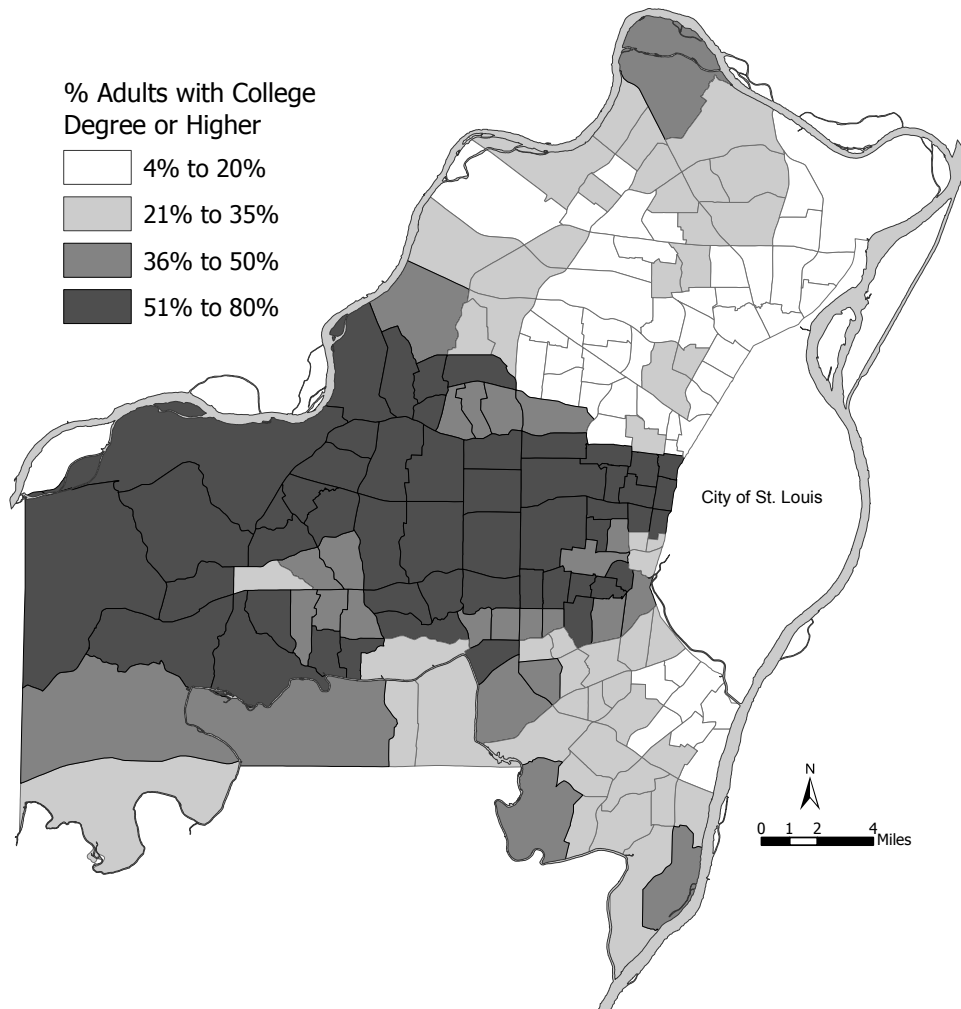


Educational Attainment by Census Tract



Adults with College Degree by Census Tract, 2000

Census tracts in which the majority of adults have a college degree are concentrated in the central corridor of the County from the St. Louis City limits to far western St. Louis County. Census tracts in which at least 36 percent of adults have college degrees include tracts in the far south Oakville area, west of there along Tesson Ferry Road (State Highway 21), and in far north county north of the City of Florissant, all areas of relatively recent housing development. Census

tracts in which the percentage of adults with college degrees is 20 percent or less are concentrated in the near north, northeast and near southeast portions of the County.

Note: Adults with college degrees are defined as persons aged 25 or older whose maximum educational achievement was a bachelor's degree or higher.
