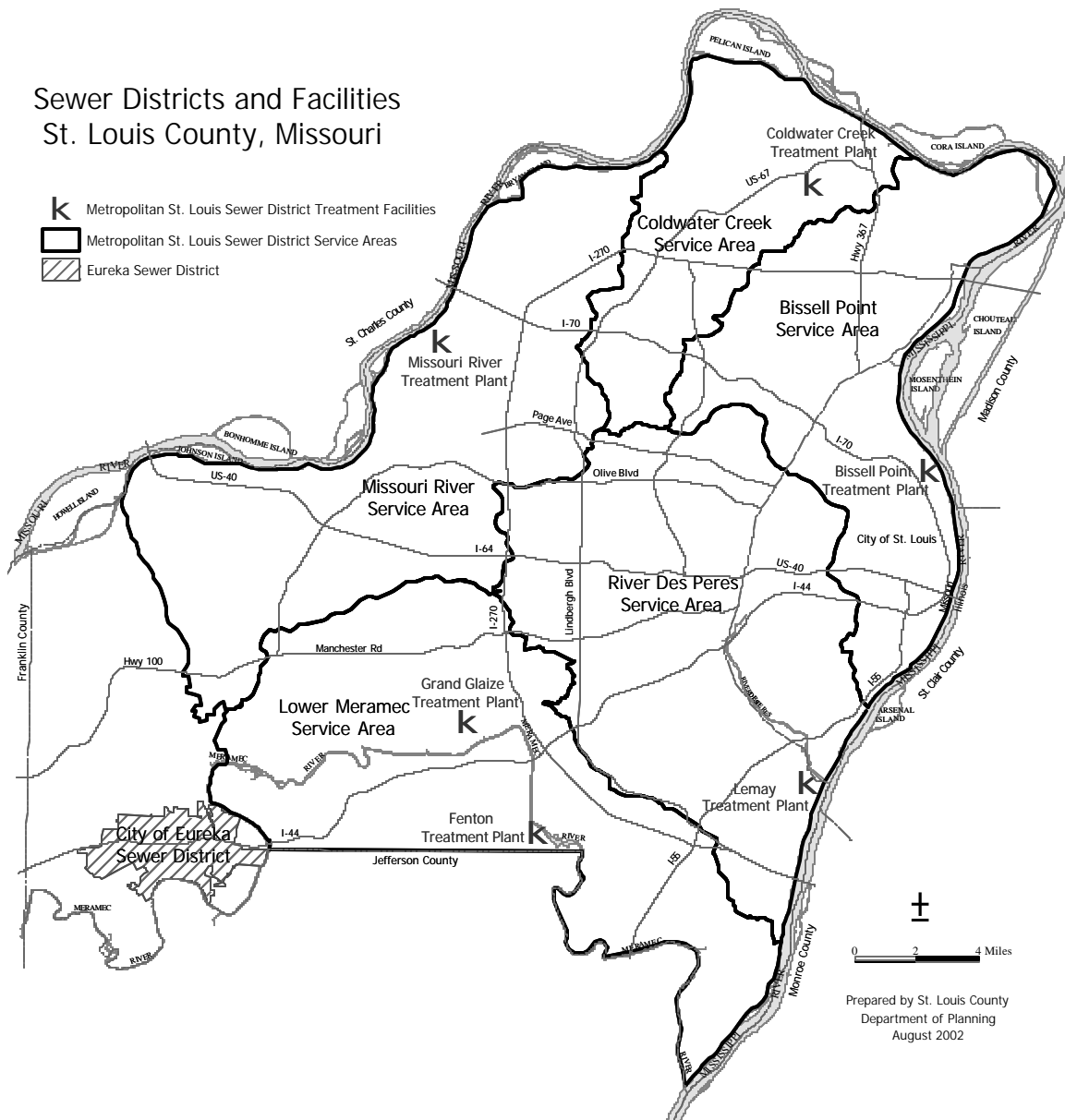


Sewer District Boundaries

The only public sewage system outside the Metropolitan Sewer District area in St. Louis County is maintained by the City of Eureka, which operates a secondary level lagoon and mechanical sewage treatment facility. Eureka's plant has a design capacity of 1 million gallons per day and is currently operating at 95 percent of the plant's capacity. Eureka has approved a new treatment facility, and completion is scheduled for the

summer of 2003. The new facility will increase the city's capacity to 2.8 million gallons per day. In areas west of Highway 109, which are outside of MSD and the City of Eureka, sewage treatment and wastewater disposal in St. Louis County are scattered and incomplete, consisting of subdivision lagoons, septic tanks and the mechanical plants or lagoons belonging to rural schools, institutions, factories and industrial parks.
