
St. Louis County Blaster's License Holder

RE: Revised Licensing Requirements

Due to the new Missouri State requirements for obtaining a blasting license, St. Louis County is changing their requirements for obtaining and/or renewing a St. Louis County Blaster's License. Although we have verbally been requesting this information for several months, beginning September 15th, 2009 proof of possession of a Missouri State Blasting License and a Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms permit/license must be submitted to receive a new County Blaster's License or to renew an existing license. This Missouri license must be kept active to utilize the St. Louis County Blaster's License. The Missouri State Blasting License must be in the name of the applicant but the BATF permit/license may be in the name of the applicant's employer.

The term of the County license will remain one year and the fee for the license or renewal will remain fifty (\$50) dollars. If you have any questions please call me at 314-615-7139 or Neil Fick at 314-615-7140.

NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING OR RENEWING A ST. LOUIS COUNTY BLASTING LICENSE

August 25, 2009

Background

Due to the new Missouri regulations governing blasting licenses St. Louis County is revising the requirements for obtaining or renewing a St. Louis County Blaster's License.

New St. Louis County Blaster's License Procedures

Effective September 15, 2009 St. Louis County will require the following information for obtaining or renewing a Blaster's License:


1. A copy of the front and reverse sides of the current State of Missouri issued blasting license. This license must be issued to the individual who is applying for a new or renewed St. Louis County Blaster's License.
2. A copy of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms permit/license. The BATF license may be issued to the individual applicant or the company in which he or she is employed.
3. A completed St. Louis County Application for License to Blast or Renewal of License to Blast.
4. If you are obtaining a new license, the St. Louis County Blasters Test must be taken and passed.
5. If renewing a license, the current license must be submitted with the renewal application. The State of Missouri blasting license must be kept current while the St. Louis County License to Blast is active.
6. A check made payable to St. Louis County Treasurer for fifty (\$50) dollars for each new or renewed license.

The term of the St. Louis County Blaster's License remains at one year and the fee will remain at fifty (\$50) dollars per new or renewed license. The application should be completed and submitted in person or by mail to the address below:


